7:30 pm – Mr. McIlroy led the pledge and asked for motion to approve June 25 minutes.

Mr. Peter said we could refer it to county. Mr. McIlroy said there were too many unanswered questions. Mr. Peter said application missing the tax map # on form. He also said there was public water available but not hooked up. They may not know that although they are paying a debt service. Mr. McIlroy said the Ag Data Statement not filled out correctly. Mr. Wall said they need a special use permit and wondered if there should be an expiration date on the permit so they could be inspected every 2 or 3 years. Mr. Dermody asked who would do it? Mr. Wall said in his other town the code enforcement officer does it every 2 years. Could county dog control do it? Mr. Wall also asked about signage. Mr. Peter said the sign couldn't be very big because it's in ag.

Mr. Witmer said look at #601 in zoning.

Mr. McIlroy said they need to explain their disposal system. Mr. Brightman said the state has regulations for kennels. Mr. Dermody asked if they have to be a licensed groomer. Mr. Brightman's biggest concern was noise for neighbors.

Mr. Wall moved to table Rustic Paws, Mr. Brightman seconded, all in favor, carried.
